This little blanket can easily be made using "scraps" from your sewing stash. Babies are naturally fascinated with tabs and labels. This little blanket gives various textures for babies' little hands.

You will Need- (Please read carefully)

- Fabric/Stabilizer
 - 12" Square of Cuddle fabric
 - 12" Square of Silky fabric
- Various Ribbon and Trims
 - 3/4 yard 7/8-inch wide rickrack
 - 7/8 yard picot bias
 - 1/8 yard of 1-inch wide gingham ribbon
 - 1/4 yard 2-inch wide satin ribbon
 - 1/4 yard 1-inch wide grosgrain ribbon
 - 1/4 yard 7/8-inch wide decorative edge ribbon
 - 1/4 yard pre-made chenille strip for cattail
 - 1/2 yard 5/8-inch wide embroidered edging with entredeux edge



(You may use whatever miscellaneous items you may find in your stash that will have a texture)

- Threads
 - Sewing threads to coordinate with fabric and trims
- Needles
 - #70 Universal Sewing needle for construction
- Notions:
 - Basic Sewing Notions
 - Scissors for cutting threads and fabric
 - Wash-away Fabric Marker
 - Glass Head Pins

Equipment

- Sewing Machine in good running order, Electric Cord, foot control and manual
- Basic machine accessories that came with machine
