Black tie has never been so adorable! For elegant dining or everyday fare, here's an easy to make and easy to care for bib with a classic look that never fails. Six 1/8" tucks make the shirt front, bordered in black classic cotton, with three small black shank buttons and a child-sized bow tie to complete the tailoring. This can also be a girl's bib by changing fabric colors and adding a puffy bow instead of a bow tie.



You will Need- (Please read carefully)

- Fabric/Stabilizer
 - 3/8 yard White Cotton Batiste
 - 3/8 yard Black Cotton (or another color for a girl bib)
 - 12" square of white flannel (can use light weight white batting)
 - 1 yard baby cord for making piping
 - Three black 1/4" shank-style buttons (or other colored shank buttons for a girl bib)
- Threads
 - Regular black thread (or color to match girl fabric)
 - Lightweight white thread
 - Heavyweight black thread for attaching bowtie and buttons
- Needles
 - #70 Universal Sewing needle for construction
 - Hand Sewing Needle for sewing buttons
- Notions:
 - Basic Sewing Notions
 - Scissors for cutting threads and fabric
 - Wash-away Fabric Marker
 - Glass Head Pins
 - Quilting Ruler for cutting fabric (suggest 6" x 24")
 - Rotary Cutter
 - Darr Piping Magic Ruler
 - 1/2" bias tape maker
